This is a general hospital offering services in most areas of health care, with the exception of OB/GYN and pediatrics. Since Barmherzigen Brueder is a large complex comprised of several different buildings which are connected, you may find it helpful to stop first at the information desk located at the main entrance.

If you are admitted to the hospital you can apply for a telephone at the main admission office (Patientenaufnahme). The phone requires a 20 Euro deposit. Basic telephone service costs 1 euro per day, plus there is an additional charge of 15 cent for each timed unit of outgoing telephone usage. Before leaving the hospital, return to the admission office to receive the remainder of your deposit, or pay charges if your telephone costs have exceeded 20 Euros. You are personally responsible for all telephone fees that you incur.

The admission office is located on the ground floor. The entrance lobby area also contains a gift shop, snack bar and hair dresser.

As is the case with all German hospitals, Barmherzigen Brueder patients must provide their own pyjamas and toiletries.

The hospital is located 36 miles south of Hohenfels and offers the following services: **Cardiology, general surgery, traumatology, hand-, neurosurgery, urology, ENT, internal medicine and nuclear medicine.**


The Krankenhaus der Barmherzigen Brueder specializes cardiology, general surgery, traumatology, hand-, neurosurgery, urology, ENT, internal medicine and nuclear medicine.

Note: there is no OB/GYN nor prenatal care available!

The number of beds is 670.

Directions how to get to the hospital:

From gate 1, JMRC Hohenfels, go straight and take the main road to Parsberg (St2234). Before reaching Parsberg get on the Autobahn A3 to Regensburg. Take the exit Weiden onto A93. Take the Pruefening exit; turn left onto Pruefeningerstrasse. Take the first exit right into the hospital parking lot.



KREISKRANKENHAUS BURGLENGENFELD

This medical facility is a general hospital with the capability of treating and stabilizing trauma patient, performing acute surgeries, and providing ENT and OB/GYN care. The facility is small and treatment tends to be more personalized. Under normal circumstances, you will be in a two bed room.

Television services require a 10 Euro deposit for the remote control which can be obtained from the information desk on the first floor. The deposit will be refunded upon return of the remote control. To receive telephone service in your room, fill out an application form at the Information Desk in the main lobby. The telephone requires a 20 Euro deposit, which is applied to the daily basic fee of 1.25 euros and the additional cost of 10 cent per timed unit of telephone usage. Before leaving the hospital, stop at the information desk to see if you receive money back on your deposit.

Snacks, coffee, tea, and fruit juices are sold at the retail window located in the lobby. Soda vending machines are also available. Parking at the facility is limited but an additional lot is located down the hill from the hospital on the main access road.

As is the case with all German hospitals, Burglengenfeld patients must provide their own pyjamas and toiletries.

The hospital is located 18 miles south-east of Hohenfels and offers the following services:

EMS with ICU, general surgery, internal medicine, ENT and OB/GYN care.



Directions how to get to the hospital:

from gate 1, JMRC Hohenfels, turn left onto St2234 and travel through Hohenfels to Rohrbach. At the T-intersection turn right onto St2165 towards Kallmuenz. Go to Kallmuenz. At Kallmuenz look for the Burglengenfeld road sign and turn left onto St2235. Cross the bridge and go straight on until you reach Burglengenfeld. You enter Burglengenfeld on Kallmuenzerstrasse. Travel several blocks into town until you turn left at the bus stop (follow the sign "Krankenhaus"). Go up Dr. Sauerbruchstrasse until you reach the hospital parking lot.

St. Josef specializes in urology, internal medicine, plastic-, general-, hand surgery, and OB/GYN. This is a very modern facility with a full staff and up-to-date equipment. Most of the rooms have only two beds, and are equipped with a telephone and a television. Television service is free, but there is a charge for the telephone. To use the phones, purchase a magnetic card for about 10 euros. The card dispenser is located in the main hospital lobby. This card will activate the telephone. The basic fee for telephone is 1.20 Euro plus an additional 20 cents for each timed unit of telephone usage on calls that you make.

There is a small store located on hospital grounds which sells basic necessities, magazines, coffee and snacks. There is also a small florist in the hospital. Parking is located in the rear of the building.

As is the case with all German hospitals, St. Josef patients must provide their own pyjamas and toiletries.



Continue on A3 to the Burgweinting exit; turn left at the traffic light onto Landshuterstrasse. About 7 stop lights down the hospital is on the right side. Parking is in the rear.

The Regensburg University Clinic is a very large medical facility, located in the south part of Regensburg, providing full scale trauma service and progressive care in almost every field of medicine, **with the exception of pediatrics and OB/Gyn**. This is a very modern facility, and it is continuously expanding. At this hospital, finding someone who speaks English is not a problem. There are televisions and telephones in every room. To activate the phone and TV, purchase a magnetic card from vending machines located on each floor. The basic fee for the phone is 35 cents per day; for each timed unit 10. With the same card you can also activate the TV. Here the basic fee is 50 cents per day and 8 cents for each 10 minutes watching. To select either or both appliances, push the appropriate button on the upper left hand side of the card vending machine. Pay parking is available in front of the hospital (1.50 euros for 3 hours; 5 Euros for the whole day).

There is a cafeteria located on the first floor, near the large spiral staircase. There is also a small store that sells flowers, magazines and snacks. If you do not wish to activate the telephone in your room, you can buy a bundespost telephone card in this small store. The Bundespost phone card can be used in the pay telephones located in the main hospital lobby. Also in the main lobby is a bank (Sparkasse) and an ATM machine. If your bank card or credit card has international capacities, you will be able to use the ATM.

As is the case with all German hospitals, Regensburg University patients must provide their own pyjamas and toiletries.



At the light turn right onto Franz-Josef-Strauss-Allee and keep straight. The hospital is on your left. There is parking in front of the hospital.

Parsberg hospital specializes in internal medicine and respiratory disease services. Although this is a small hospital, they practice very up-to-date medicine. They are not able to perform surgery, provide OB/Gyn care, or offer pediatric services. Several English speaking doctors and nurses are available. This a newly built/renovated structure where you will usually share the room with only one other patient.

Please contact the Patient Admission Office at the main entrance of the hospital. You may bring your own TV and VCR if outlets are available to accommodate them. To receive a telephone go to the patient admission office on the first floor. A 20 Euro deposit is required. They will assign you a telephone number and give you a code number to ensure only you make calls on the phone. Before leaving the hospital, return to the admission office to settle your telephone bill or get a refund of your deposit.

This facility does not have a cafeteria, but coffee and drinks vending machines are located on the ground floor, near the main entrance and upstairs.

As is the case with all German hospitals, Parsberg patients must provide their own pyjamas and toiletries.

The hospital is located 10 miles west of Hohenfels and offers the following services: **Internal medicine but no CT, MRI or neurological services. They cooperate with the Neumarkt hospital.**



Directions how to get to the hospital:

From gate 1 go straight and take the main road to Parsberg (St2234). After the railroad underpass turn left onto Bahnhofstrasse. Pass the Bahnhof (train station) on your left and the school complex on your right. At the T-intersection turn right onto Lupburgerstrasse. Travel up the hill. After approximately 300 yards the hospital is on your right. Parking on your left.

The Klinikum Neumarkt is a general hospital, offering care in most medical fields, but only limited pediatrics. The hospital was completely renovated and provides very modern medicine. They have the large chemotherapy treatment program.

A telephone is available in the room. To receive phone service, purchase a magnetic card from the vending machine in the lobby, close to the front entrance. This deposit will be refunded when you return the card to the machine located to the left of the card dispenser. German TV is available in the rooms, but you may bring in your personal TV and VCR if outlets are available to accommodate them.

There is a small store that sells drinks and snacks which is connected to a cafeteria that provides limited service.

The OB/Gyn ward has special visiting hours. During the following hours, only husbands are welcome: 8-9:30, 12:30-13:30, and 16:30-17:30.

As is the case with all German hospitals, patients at the Neumarkt Klinikum must provide their own pyjamas and toiletries.

The hospital is located 25 miles north-west of Hohenfels and offers the following services:

EMS, internal medicine, obstetrics, gynecology, surgery, ENT, limited pediatric services. All pediatric ICU patients, complicated obstetric and neurosurgery cases are transferred to the University Clinic of Erlangen.



Directions how to get to the hospital:

From gate 1 go straight and take the main road towards Parsberg (St2234). Get on the Autobahn A3 to Nuernberg. Take the Neumarkt exit – you are now on B299a. After about 1 mile at the T-intersection turn right onto B299a/Ambergerstrasse. At the first traffic light turn left and follow the sign "Stadtmitte". After another 4 traffic light turn right onto Nuernbergerstrasse (follow the sign B-8 Nuernberg/Postbauer Heng). The hospital is on the right about one block down the street. Parking is located behind the building. Follow the signs.

St. Hedwigs Clinic specializes in pediatric, neonatal and OB/GYN care. One parent is welcome to stay with a child. Tokens for free meals for the accompanying parent can be obtained from the patient admission office on the first floor.

PLEASE NOTE: THERE ARE NO BEDS FOR HUSBANDS IN THE OB/DELIVERY WARDS!

St. Hedwigs also offers highly advanced OB care and all modern OB facilities. They have a homestyle room available for early labor, as well as special options for more advanced labor including whirlpool baths, birthing chairs and birthing tables which patients can adjust themselves to suit their own preferences.

To have a telephone installed in the room please refer to the separate instructions in this handout.

The hospital does not have a cafeteria, but there are vending machines with hot and cold drinks on the second floor. The bakery across the street offers coffee, tea, bottled soda and juices, along with the usual fare of pastries and sandwiches.

As is the case with all German hospitals, St. Hedwigs patients must provide their own pyjamas and toiletries.

The hospital is located 36 miles south of Hohenfels and offers the following services:

Obstetrics and gynecological care, pediatrics, neonatal and general pediatric care are for children up to 12 years of age. ICU for pediatric and obstetric cases.

Dear Patient:

We would like to congratulate you on the birth of your new baby. We would like to inform you that it is your responsibility to register your new baby with the Regensburg registration office (Standesamt) within five (5) days after the birth, as required by the City of Regensburg. In order to complete the registration, you will need a birth announcement form, which has to be obtained from the hospital/nurse. This form must be completed and turned into the Patient Admission Office (Patientenaufnahme).

Opening hours for the Patient Admission Office are:

Mon - Thur 08:00-12:00 hrs and 13:00-16:00 hrs

And

Fri 08:00-12:00 hrs

Upon completion, the Patient Admission Office will then forward the birth announcement to the Standesamt. Upon discharge from St. Hedwigs, parents must take the below listed documents to the **Standesamt Hohenfels, Mr Hirschmann (0947209401)**:

- a. for a married couple:
 - the original marriage certificate
 - passports
 - ID cards
 - Mother's birth certificate

- b. for a single mother:
 - Mother's birth certificate
 - Mother's passport or ID card

After you have obtained the German birth certificate your military personnel office can assist you in registering your baby for a US birth certificate and passport.

Please remember to contact the Hohenfels Health Clinic to have your baby registered in TRICARE.

Instructions How to activate the telephone

1. Go to the nurses station and ask for your room number, the phone number next to your bed and which floor you are on.

1st floor = EG

2nd floor = 1. Stock

3rd floor = 2. Stock

4th floor = 3. Stock

**Example: Obstetrics = EG
Patient's room number = 018
phone number is = 216**

2. Go to the information desk and give them the information described in item 1.

They will enter the data into the computer. Then you will receive

> a chipcard

> a telephone application

> instructions

**The chipcard is needed for the "BGT" terminal located across the information desk.
Insert the chipcard into the terminal.**

The display will show a Euro amount needed as deposit for the card which will be returned to you when you give back the card.

Instructions how to activate your telephone

1. Go to the information (ground floor) and get the card for the telephone
2. Go to the machine “Telefonautomat” (across from the information desk)
3. insert your card
4. insert Euros (at least 20)
5. press the green knob (your card will be ejected)
Your card is now activated for 5 Euros with a 15 Euro deposit fee (for the card) which will be returned upon discharge.

In your room:

A. You want to activate your phone:

1. Lift the receiver
2. Press the * button and key in your 7 digit code number
3. Hang up the receiver

Your phone is activated.

B. You want to make a call:

1. Lift the receiver
2. Dial 0
3. Dial the number you want to call

C. You can receive calls. Your number is: 0941- 369 ... (your 4 digit number).

D. You want to lock your phone:

1. Lift the receiver
2. Press # and key in your 7 digit code number
3. Hang up the receiver

Your phone is locked.

E. You want to unlock your phone:

See instructions under A.

F. You want to get your deposit back:

1. Go to the Telefonautomat on the ground floor.
2. Insert your card
3. Press “Abrechnen”; if there is a minus before the amount listed you have to pay this, otherwise you will not get your deposit back.
4. Press “Beleg”, the card will be taken and you get the receipt.

G. The machine erroneously took your card (due to improper use of the machine):

1. Go to the information desk and get a new one.


