Colonel Judith A. Lee attended the University of Massachusetts at Amherst and graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Nursing in 1986. She was commissioned into the United States Army. She received a Master of Science in Nursing from Emory University in 1997. COL Lee is a graduate of the U.S. Army Medical Detachment (AMEDD) Basic Course, AMEDD Advance Course, Command and General Staff College and the Army War College.

COL Lee's assignments have included Tripler Army Medical Center and Schofield Barracks Health Clinic in Hawaii, JTF Bravo in Honduras, Martin Army Community Hospital, and the 14th Combat Support Hospital at Ft. Benning Georgia, 44th Medical Command and Womack Army Medical Center at Fort Bragg, N.C., Bagram, Afghanistan and Baghdad, Iraq. After graduate school COL Lee served as a Nurse Practitioner at Martin Army Community Hospital at Fort Benning from June 1997 to May 2000.



Upon completion of the resident Command and General Staff College in June 2001 she returned to the 14th Field Hospital to serve as the Chief Nurse and Executive Officer. In September 2001 the 14th Field Hospital deployed to Egypt in support of Bright Star. COL Lee assumed command of the 14th Field Hospital on 31 January 2002. In March 2003 she was assigned to the 44th Medical Command at Fort Bragg. In April 2003 she deployed to Afghanistan in support of Operation Enduring Freedom and served as Chief of Plans and Operations in the XVIII Airborne Corps Joint Operations Center. She then served as the Officer in Charge of the 44th Medical Command 91W Transition School. In November 2004 she deployed as the Chief Nurse of the 86th Combat Support Hospital in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. Returning to Fort Bragg in November 2005 she served as the Chief, Medical/Surgical Nursing, at Womack Army Medical Center. In 2009 to 2010 she served as the Commander of the 14th Combat Support Hospital (CSH). The 14th CSH did a one year tour of duty in Iraq, 2009-2010, under her leadership. Completing the Army War College in June 2012, COL Lee served as the Deputy Commander for Patient Services at Womack Army Medical Center until 30 Sept 2012. She then served as the FORSCOM Command Surgeon from 1 OCT 2012 to 17 May 2013. COL Lee is currently Commander of Landstuhl Regional Medical Center, Germany.

COL Lee's awards and decorations include the Legion of Merit, Bronze Star Medal with one oak leaf cluster (OLC), Meritorious Service Medal with three OLCs, the Army Commendation Medal with two OLCs and the Army Achievement Medal with one OLC, the Expert Field Medal Badge, Airborne Badge and Air Assault Badge, Meritorious Unit Citation and the Order of Military Medical Merit. She was selected as the University of Massachusetts at Amherst School of Nursing 2007 Distinguished Alumni. In July 2010 the Daughters of the American Revolution National Society awarded COL Lee the Dr. Anita Newcomb McGee Army Nurse Corps leadership award.
