- Patient care and safety is the top priority for Soldier readiness and will not be compromised to achieve the mission.

SMRC Tasks

◉ Physical Processing

- Initiating and reviewing of all adult physicals
 - Retirement, chapter, ETS, flight, Warrant, PHA, PDHA, etc.
- Initial flight and all flight crew physicals for those soldiers in the region (EUCOM and AFRICOM) not having embedded a Flight surgeon.

◉ Coordinate SRP/PDP

- Individual and smaller groups
- Larger units will be coordinated with approval from the WAHC

SMRC Physicals

- All Army physicals will be completed according to AR 40-501.
- Physical Forms: DD 2697, 2808, 2807-1, 2351, 2492 and DA 4497
- The list consist of, but is not limited to.
 - Chapter/ETS/Retirement
 - Initial Entry
 - OCS/Warrant
 - SF/SERE/HALO/Diving
 - Airborne
 - Ranger
 - Initial Flight
 - Long Flight
 - Short Flight

How to Book a PHA & Physicals

PHA

- You can call PHA Hotline
- You can submit a request via SMRC Email
- You can schedule via walk-in encounter

PHYSICALS

- You can only schedule via walk-in encounter

Physical Preparation Checklist

1. Online portion of PHA, DHAs must be completed through AKO prior to appointment
2. Have all required paper work presents for all physicals
3. Required paper work must be completely filled out prior to appointment
4. Bring your glasses for PHA and/or all physicals.
5. For hearing, go to BLDG 1517 (behind the chapel) between 1300-1500 (Monday-Thursday)
6. Males and Females 40+ must come in fasting.
 - No food 12 hours prior, no exercise that morning, only water to drink.
7. **ARMY PHYSICALS:**
**All personnel must be fasting. No food 12 hours prior, no exercise that morning, only water to drink.*
8. **CIVILIAN PHYSICALS:**
**Bring your third party insurance card and Authorization Memo

MILITARY

- MEDPROS is used to track U.S. Army, Reserve and National Guard medical history. This site is an official government medical site.
- Any changes to done to a Soldiers medical records can only be done by approved and trained personnel.

MEDPROS CONTD.

- Vision- done annually, patients with glasses must update with glasses. The patient will need 2 pairs of glasses with inserts.
- Hearing- Is based on MOS/JOB, majority done every 2 years.
- DHA- track pre/post deployment assessments as well as ANAM testing and PHA's.
- Immunizations- will prescreen and cross reference with AHLTA for needed immunizations. Immunizations will be administered at the WAHC

FLIGHT PHYSICALS

- All flight physical will be completed IAW AR 40-501.
- AERO is used by the U.S. Army, Reserve, National Guard, Navy and Marines to track and verify flight physical status and medical history. This site is an official government medical site and may only be accessed and changed by authorized personnel.
- Initial- (pilots) SIFT test, Form DD 2808 and DD 2807-1.
- Short- Form DA 4497 and DD 2807-1.
- Long- Forms 2808 and 2807-1.
- Class IV- Rated ATC
- Class III- Rated crew member
- Class II- Rated pilot
- Class I- Initial

Make sure to check your
My Medical Readiness page on
AKO at least once a month.
